Number one, they could look at diversifying their markets, diversifying their supply chains... They can also leverage trade agreements. So this is a good opportunity to look at other markets and understand whether there are other trade agreements that can be leveraged to encourage new partnerships in those countries where Canada's products could be imported on a duty free basis. And that's an interesting way to diversify the supply chain.
